Dear Parents,

Thank you to the few parents who came to the reading and maths information workshops. The staff spent a long time putting together ideas for helping your child at home, if you were unable to come but would still like some information please see our school website or speak to Mr Llewellyn (Maths) or Miss Robinson (English).

This term we have had lots of sickness and diarrhoea bugs—please keep your child away from school for 48 hours from the last bout of the illness, this will stop it spreading to the other children. Please encourage your child to wash their hands with soap after they have been to the toilet, this also helps to stop spreading germs.

Can I remind you once again about parking issues around school. We have received a letter of complaint from a resident in Jury Lane about parents blocking her drive. She has reported this to the police and local council and included photographs of number plates with it. Please remember that you can use Tesco carpark and walk across so there is no need to park in Jury Lane nor to park on the double yellow lines outside of school gates, the police will be patrolling next term. If you have a taxi waiting, please do not let them park on the double yellow lines. In the Autumn term we will be having building works in the carpark at the end of the Yr 2 block; this will mean that the carpark will **ONLY** be able to be used by the LA School Travel Service on a restricted basis. There will be absolutely no parking for parents in this area as there will be construction traffic and restricted access. Pedestrians will not be allowed to use this area. Health and safety from the Local Authority and Building Control will be controlling access for the traffic on site.

Next term is a very busy one as you will see from the entire page of dates on the back. Additionally to those already planned, there maybe some more exciting trips or activities for different classes. There will also be transition visits for children up to their new classes and reports home from your child's teacher. Information will come out next term regarding who your child's new teacher will be and how the classes will be organised—this has not been decided yet.
