

Dear Parents,

We are aware that it is a very worrying time for all of us as the virus seems to be right on our doorstep and within our community. Please be assured that we continue everyday with our procedures to keep children and staff safe at Fenton, but we cannot protect nor prevent what is happening in the community.

We have set procedures and guidelines to follow in school and ask you to help us by;

- Keeping your child at home if they have a new continuous cough, or a temperature or if they have lost their sense of taste or smell. Please inform us if they have <u>any</u> of these symptoms—they <u>do not</u> have to have all 3. Siblings will need to stay at home as well even if they do not have any symptoms until a negative test result is received.
- Inform us if anyone in your household is having a Covid test and keep your child at home whilst you await the result.
- 3) Do not attend school to drop off or pick up a child if you are currently waiting for test results or about to have a test.
- 4) Please send a screen shot of test results on Dojo to Miss Hayley Morgan—attendance officer, so we can complete our paperwork and your child/ren may then return to school.

If any child or staff member in school has a positive test result then again we have immediate protocols to follow.

If you are informed by Track and Trace of a positive result you must inform them of the School's details and contact the school via Dojo with a screen shot of the result. We will ask you for your test number—you should have this information. If this should happen over half term then you must email the following address and let them know:

education.coronavirus@pembrokeshire.gov.uk

The Local Authority will get in touch with me directly over half term if you have informed them that your child has a positive test result.

If we receive information of a positive test result and your child has been in that contact group then you will be informed directly and informed to isolate. If you <u>do not</u> get informed, then your child has not been in that contact group and can continue to come to school. We are very aware of the anxiety this causes you but please remember we cannot share details of who has received a positive test result, only if your child is in the contact group. We will close down 'bubbles' - classes or year groups if necessary for 2 weeks isolation. If this happens you will be informed and home learning will re-commence for your child whilst they do not attend school.

If your child has any symptoms and you are in any doubt, please ring and someone will be able to help you.
